GOLDEN STATE WARRIORS @ SAN ANTONIO SPURS

Game Time: 7:30 PM EST

Game Pick: TOTAL UNDER 244 POINTS

Greetings friends !!!

For our Dr. Alan NBA special release for Friday 1-13-23 we are going to take the total to go UNDER 244 total points in this Western Conference matchup between the Golden State Warriors vs. the San Antonio Spurs

DR. ALAN'S GAME ANALYSIS

- This game will be played in the Alamo Dome in San Antonio, **this is NOT at the regular home of the Spurs !!!**
- This Alamo Dome is a football size indoor arena, and the Spurs are expecting a record-breaking crowd of 63,000 people to attend this game !!!
- The Warriors are 2-3 O/U in their last 5 games.
- The Spurs are 4-1 O/U in their last 5 games.
- These 2 squads played earlier this year at Golden State and the final score was : Warriors 132 Spurs 95 = 227 total points !!!
- With this being a " SPECIAL GAME " for the Spurs playing in front of a record-breaking crowd of 63,000 people, I expect to see a better defensive effort vs. the Warriors in this game, compared to the 132 points they gave up defensively in their first match up vs. the Warriors !!!
- In the last 8 games that these 2 squads have played against each other, the cumulative total record is an UNDER whelming 1-6-1 O/U !!!
- Warriors' superstar Stephen Curry just returned back to the Warriors line up from his shoulder injury in their last game vs. the Suns. Stephen Curry contributed 24 points in that loss to the Suns, which is below average for his normal offensive production.
- With a HIGH total of 244 points, the Question (?) becomes can each squad do their part and contribute 122 points to the total ?
- Answer: YES THEY CAN & but also, YES THEY CAN'T !!!
- By the RECENT numbers (#'s) for both squads, the Warriors have scored 122 or more total points in only 1 out of their 5 games !!! And, in only 2 out of their last 10 games !!!
- The Spurs ALSO have scored 122 or more points in only 1 out of their last 5 games !!!

And, in only 4 out of their last 10 games !!!

- As previously mentioned, this game will be played in a football size arena. This throws off the " DEPTH PERCEPTION " of the shooters.
- In the majority of games, both in NCAA college basketball & NBA pro basketball, when the game is played in a football size arena, the made FG % drops, and in many of those games, it dropped dramatically !!!
- With a total this HIGH of 244 total points, everything has to go perfectly right under NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES for this game to go OVER i.e.- the game being played in a normal NBA arena, the pace of play being fast, with the scoring & the made FG % as usual, with not many " dry possessions " with no points being scored.
- All it will take for this game to go UNDER 244 total points even with a " fast pace ", is a little bit of defense, a few " dry possessions ", and the made FG % to slightly go down, due to the " DEPTH PERCEPTION " problems !!!
- We will be making our selection on the total to go UNDER 244 total points in this NBA Western Conference battle between the Warriors vs. the Spurs in the Lone Star State !!!
